

ITF World Tennis Masters Tour - World Team Championships

Individual Ranking Points Allocation

The following criteria is in place to award ITF World Tennis Masters Tour (“WTMT”) Ranking Points to players competing in the ITF WTMT World Team Championships.

Players can compete in a maximum of 6 matches during the Team event. For example, in a 23-team event, a team may play in a Round Robin Box of 4 teams (3 matches) and progress to Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Final. Whilst some teams can play 5 or 6 matches, several teams may play only 4 matches.

- Individual players will earn accumulated ranking points for each match (rubber) won.
- The best four (4) results – based on ranking points earned – for each player will be added together to determine the points earned during the World Team Championships.
- Players will earn a minimum of 1 ranking point for competing in the World Team Championships.
- Points are earned based on the round in which the match was played, as defined below.
- Singles and Doubles points will be applied separately as is the case in Individual Tournaments. The following tables demonstrate how points will be awarded:

Round Robin Stage

All match wins at the Round Robin stage will earn players the same value of ranking points.

Round of Match	#1 Singles and #1 Doubles	#2 Singles
Round Robin Stage (Days 1-3 of Team Event) Includes any Round-Robin draw in second stage of competition (Days 4-6) for 4 th position onwards.	100 points per win	75 points per win

Second Stage Play-Off Draws

Following the round robin stages (Days 1-3), additional points may be earned from players competing in the remaining days of competition which recognise the increased strength of opponent.

Round of Match	#1 Singles and #1 Doubles	#2 Singles
Non-Main Draw Playoff Matches	100 points per win	75 points per win
Main Draw Quarter Finals and 5 th -8 th place playoffs	175 points per win	125 points per win
Main Draw Semi Finals and 3 rd /4 th place playoff and Second Stage Round-Robin groups for 1 st -3 rd place	225 points per win	175 points per win
Main Draw Final (1 st /2 nd elimination match only)	350 points per win	300 points per win

Player 1 Example

Team does not qualify for the Main Draw

- Player wins 2 matches at #1 singles in the Round Robin Stage = 100 + 100
- Player wins 1 further match at #1 singles in the Playoff Stages = 100
- Player total = 300 points (3 wins * 100 points per win)

Player 2 Example

Team qualifies for Main Draw

- Player wins 2 matches at #2 singles in the Round Robin Stage = 75 points + 75 points
- Player wins match at #2 singles in the Quarter Finals = 125 points
- Player loses match in the Semi Finals = 0 points
- Player wins match at #1 singles in 3rd/4th Playoff = 225 points
- Player total = 500 points (Best 4 results = 75 + 75 + 125 + 225)

Player 3 Example

Team wins the event and player wins all doubles matches played.

- Player wins 2 matches in doubles in the Round Robin Stage = 100 + 100 points
- Player wins doubles match in Quarter Finals = 175 points
- Player wins doubles match in Semi Finals = 225 points
- Player wins doubles match in Final = 350 point
- Player total = 850 points based on best 4 results (100+175+225+350).

The examples above show successful players winning multiple matches. Most players will not win 3+ matches in this way and will likely earn points equivalent to MT400 tournaments should they win matches in any respective event. A total of 850 points is the maximum points total that can be earned if a player wins all matches up to and including the Gold Medal match.

Comparison with Individual Event(s)

For comparison, the table below shows the points that will be earned by players at the ITF WTMT World Individual Championships as well as from MT1000, MT700 and MT400 tournaments.

Tournament Grade / Round	Winner	Final	SF	QF	R16	R32
World Individual Championships	1600	1100	800	550	375	220
MT1000 Grade	1000	700	500	330	210	140
MT700 Grade	700	500	330	210	140	75
MT400 Grade	400	280	190	120	80	40

When will I see my Ranking Points?

Points will be allocated to players on the Monday immediately following the completion of the Team Event. E.g., The 2023 ITF WTMT 30, 35, 40, 45, 50 World Team Championships points from Turkiye will be included in the Rankings Run on Monday 27 March 2023.
