| Entries | <p>Players can submit entries for up to three (3) tournaments in a given tournament week up to the time of the Entry Deadline. No entries will be accepted after this deadline (apart from Wild Cards).</p> <p>All entries must be submitted via IPIN - no entries will be accepted if submitted directly to the Tournament Director (apart from Wild Cards).</p> | | | |
| Entry Rank Deadline | Ranking for tournament acceptance into tournaments will be based on the ITF Wheelchair Tennis Rankings published on the Monday prior to the Entry Deadline. | 42 days Monday prior to Entry Deadline | 28 days Monday prior to Entry Deadline | 28 days Monday prior to Entry Deadline |
| Entry Deadline | <p>Occurs on a Wednesday each week for all tournaments starting in the same Tournament week. No further entries can be made after the Entry Deadline.</p> <p>Tournament entry lists are sorted by Entry Ranking, and sectioned into draws to create Acceptance Lists.</p> | 40 days prior to the Monday of the Tournament week Wednesday, 14h00 GMT | 26 days prior to the Monday of the tournament week Wednesday, 14h00 GMT | 26 days prior to the Monday of the tournament week Wednesday, 14h00 GMT |
| 6 (20 for GS) Days  | <p>Players on Acceptance Lists are not yet committed to play in any tournament for that Tournament Week, and can withdraw from any Acceptance List without penalty until the time of the Withdrawal Deadline.</p> <p>Players are responsible for monitoring their entries and should withdraw themselves from all but one tournament by the Withdrawal Deadline.</p> | | | |
| Withdrawal Deadline | <p>Occurs on a Tuesday each week for all tournaments starting in the same Tournament Week.</p> <p>Players remaining on more than one Acceptance List will be withdrawn automatically according to fixed criteria, so as to remain on only one Acceptance List.</p> | | 20 days prior to the Monday of the Tournament week Tuesday, 14h00 GMT | |
| 16 Days  | <p>Withdrawals made after the Withdrawal Deadline are considered Late.</p> <p>A player's first three Late Withdrawals in a calendar year are excused (Withdrawal Amnesty) and no reason or medical certificate needs to be submitted. But any subsequent Late Withdrawals will be penalised according to the Code of Conduct, regardless of the reason.</p> <p>All withdrawals must be made via IPIN. Players from the alternate/qualifying will continue to move up into an Acceptance List should a place become available. Alternates should ensure they withdraw should they not be prepared to play an event. An alternate who withdraws does not count as a late withdrawal.</p> | | | |
| Freeze Deadline | <p>Occurs on a Thursday each week for all tournaments starting in the same Tournament Week.</p> <p>After this, the Acceptance List is frozen, meaning when there is a withdrawal no player will move up into a draw to fill the vacancy. This avoids players becoming committed to a tournament very late.</p> <p>For example, following a withdrawal, the first Alternate will remain as first Alternate and will not move up into a Main Draw. However, if that player chooses to sign-in on-site they would be guaranteed to fill the vacancy.</p> | | 4 days prior to the Monday of the Tournament week Thursday, 14h00 GMT | |

| On-site Alternates | Players are able to sign-in on-site to fill vacancies in a draw. | | Singles sign-in deadline | |
